1. Applicants must be currently enrolled as a senior in a public or private high school or enrolled in a licensed home schooling program within Kingsport/Sullivan County.
2. Applicants must demonstrate a commitment to volunteerism through an outstanding record of participation and leadership in service-oriented activities. These activities may include, but are not limited to: civic activities, church activities, scouting activities or any other community service (either through an established service agency or individually).
3. Applicants must have maintained a consistent record of academic achievement within a challenging curriculum. Current transcripts should be included with application.
